# INTRODUCTION

## MAIN CAMP



**Z**ingela Safaris is located in the Zulu Kingdom halfway between Durban and Johannesburg on the banks of the mighty Tugela River. We form part of a 6000 ha community and privately owned conservation area and are home to the largest and possibly last free ranging population of Giraffe in South Africa. The terrain is rugged enough and remote enough for us to be unfenced and our animals (and guests) roam free. Interconnecting this incredible landscape are over 100km of hiking, running and paddling trails designed to give you access to the best that the area has to offer. Our bush camps and lodges have been hand crafted from natural materials and offer guests a choice of accommodation including Fully Catered romantic en-suite chalets, Self Catered chalets & safari tents as well as campsites and Wild Camping. As a family run business we pride ourselves on our warm hospitality, excellent service, amazing food and fun activities. Join us and abseil down the crags, try your hand at fly fishing or river raft down the Tugela River - you won't be disappointed!

The indicated prices are per person sharing per unit; with a 50% discount for children ages 3 - 12 years old. There is no charge for infants under 3 years of age. We have a once-off Community Conservation Fee which is charged at R90 per adult and R45 per child. This fee is allocated to conserving river health, maintaining hiking trails, and increasing the conservation footprint in the Tugela Valley. Members of the local community are employed to fulfill these roles. We have a whole range of adventurous activities which are optional extras.

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# ACTIVITIES

The Zulu Kingdom boasts superb all year round sub-tropical weather with an average of 320 days of sunshine a year! Zingela's average rainfall of 600mm falls mainly over the summer months This is when the peaceful Tugela wakes up from its hibernation and provides some of the most exhilarating white water rafting in the country. The camp is ideally situated for paddling, guided game walks, birding, trail running, mountain biking or fishing. Sitting in the shade of a thorn tree with a good book is also a wonderful alternative. African time rules here and the Tree of Idleness might find you a common visitor!

Adventure activities are largely dictated by the seasons and nature has provided a wonderful playground. The river for rafting, kayaking and fishing; the cliffs for rock climbing and abseiling and spectacular terrain for 4x4s, quad and mountain biking. The variety of flora and fauna make every walk an adventure.

## WHITE WATER RAFTING & KAYAKING

From Mild (Grade 1) to Wild (Grade 5) our 20km stretch of the Tugela River has rapids and runs suitable for all ages and experience levels. Water levels alter the mood of the river but whether the river rises (along with adrenalin levels) or whether the water slows to a sedate experience, these adventure trips are unforgettable as you journey through the impressive Tugela Canyon. Rafting on big water is traditionally between November and April but as always Mother Nature has the final say! On big water we use the eight and four man rafts while in lower water the two man crocs and one- and two-man sit on top kayaks are preferable.

**Rates: R350 pp for a half day trip R700 for a full day epic adventure.**

River trips start at 10H00 and 14H00. This activity must be booked and paid prior to your arrival to ensure that we have sufficient qualified guides for these adventures.

## MOUNTAIN BIKING & ADVENTURE BIKES.

Zingela offers some wonderful single track riding interspersed with a network of rugged 4x4 jeep tracks. The abundance of game in the bushveld adds to the riding experience with Giraffe, Kudu or Impala seemingly around every corner. Guests are welcome to bring their own mountain bikes and have free range of Zingela. If you intend to bring quad or motorbikes please inform us beforehand so that there is no clash with quiet weekend retreats or hunting. Please may you kindly adhere to our policy of no high speed riding on Zingela itself. Zingela is a game reserve and thus we ask bikers to ride slowly and keep noise levels to a minimum when on the property, in order to respect the animals and other guests. Please leave your bikes in the parking area - no bikes allowed past the rock wall at the entrance to main camp. There is however ample riding within a few kilometers of our Camp and we will happily provide you with directions and routes allowing you to explore this incredible wilderness area.



# ACTIVITIES

## ABSEILING

The cliffs overlooking the Tugela Canyon provide dizzying abseil sites. Face your fear or watch other participants step over the edge. Registered, experienced guides are there to provide reassurance and safety.

**R320 per person, half price for children (3 - 12 yrs).**

This activity must be booked and paid for prior to your arrival to ensure that we have sufficient qualified guides for these adventures.

## ROCK CLIMBING

We have set up a rock-climbing wall just upriver of the main camp; which provides a great opportunity for children and beginners to get the hang of rock climbing and a small abseil.

**R200 per person, half price for children (3 - 12 yrs).**

## FLY FISHING

Fly fishing for Yellows in the Tugela river is not only a sport but a passion. With over 20km of river to explore you are spoilt for choice! Please support our Tugela River Conservation initiative by paying a R150 once-off fishing permit fee per person. Half price for minors (3 - 12 years old). Funds are used for research, river cleanups and community benefits. Please request a copy of Zingela's fishing policy if you would like more information.

## JAMES CAMP




James's camp consists of 2 rooms, 4 safari tents and 2 two large central areas; one of which is equipped as a self-catering kitchen, and the other as the dining room/ lounge area. An exquisite reservoir style pool makes it the ideal venue to book out for family or friend groups. It offers a relatively private area away from the busyness of the main camp. It is ideal for kiddies due to the pool, large lawns in front, the sandy "beach" next to the river, and the swing hammocks.

Please note that we can only guarantee exclusivity of the James camp self-catering facilities if you book both rooms and all four safari tents. Alternatively, you are welcome to book meals at the restaurant. Please indicate on booking if meals will be required.

This charming double-volume thatch cottage sleeps up to four people in an open-air arrangement. Comprising a queen-sized bed on ground level, and two single beds upstairs, James 1 is spacious and extremely comfortable. The quaint en-suite bathroom has a loo, basin and an open-air shower. Guests staying in James 1 have access to James Camp swimming pool; and a large undercover entertainment area, as well as a self-catering kitchen.

This spacious rondavel comprises a queen sized bed and a single bed with an en-suite bathroom. Guests staying in James 2 have access to James Camp swimming pool; a large undercover entertainment area, as well as a self-catering kitchen. It is in close proximity to these facilities. There is a beautiful lawn which sprawls onto the banks of the Tugela River in front of James camp.



The recently re-thatched old farmhouse gets the first and last of the winter sun. The position of the house gives those who stay there a panoramic, eagles-eye view of the majestic Tugela river. It consists of 5 bedrooms, two of which have en-suite toilets (room 4 & 5), as well as a self-catering kitchen and a paved courtyard leading down to a little plunge pool. The outside showers boast the most incredible views over the valley. This is an ideal venue for small groups; family functions or those who need privacy and ninterrupted inspiration! The accommodation is about 1km away from main camp so pack your day bag and take a gentle stroll down the stairs, past James camp towards main camp to join us for activities or meals. Or you may prefer to take a short drive between the two camps.



These tents can be set up wherever you wish such as at Camp site, James' camp or House on Hill, where you have access to a self-catering kitchen, braai facilities and ablutions. This usually works well as part of a group that is already booked into James' camp or House on Hill, for example. Alternatively, if you are feeling adventurous, we can set these dome tents up at our "wild camping" sites such as Marula bend, Warthog island or Finger Rock. The camping possibilities are endless and can be adapted to your needs.

# CAMPING

## CAMPING

Safari Camp site is situated between Main camp and James' camp and boasts a funky open air communal kitchen with braai facilities; 3 hot water showers and 3 separate toilets. There are 8 permanent safari tents in Safari Camp Site, six of which are 2 - 3 sleepers. Safari tents 5 and 8 are family rooms (4 sleepers). Safari Camp Site offers lovely, shady spots to hang your hammock and read your book, and a cozy campfire to enjoy sundowners. It is a beautiful area suitable for those looking to be relatively close to the Main Camp but still enjoy being self-sufficient.

Our newest camp site; "Wedding Camp Site is situated just downstream from James's camp; over the little bridge (mind the trolls!), and past Badlands. It is next to majestic cliffs, which catch the last rays of the winter sun, and offers a beautiful river frontage where you can cast your line. There are 4 permanent safari tents at Wedding Camp Site which are all 2 - 3 sleepers. It has a newly built safari-style ablution block and dish-washing area. There are currently no self-catering facilities here; so please bring your own catering equipment. Alternatively; you have the option to use James' camp kitchen if you are part of that group; or join us at main camp for pre-booked meals.

Other popular spots for camping are James' camp or House on Hill. This usually works well as part of a group that is already booked into James' camp or House on Hill.

# WILD CAMPING

If you are feeling adventurous, you can set up your camp at our wild camping sites; Marula bend; Warthog island or Finger Rock. Marula bend camp site is upstream of camp and has 1 toilet; a bucket shower; a JoJo tank with river water, but no electricity. Warthog island has 2 toilets and 3 showers. Warthog island is quite literally an island when the river is full; which makes it inaccessible at times, especially in summer. Finger Rock campsite is very remote, about 6 km downriver from main camp, and has no facilities.

Please note that you will need to bring ALL your own camping equipment, water, etc. for this wild campsite. It is just you and nature in splendid isolation!

There is an option to set up extra dome tents at these camp sites if required. You are welcome to join us at the main camp for pre-booked meals and activities.



Zingela is a prime choice for research based conservation field trips as it is safe, interesting and diverse with great opportunities for structured and semi structured educational activities. It is a truly African destination that is wild yet not dangerous, exciting yet not scary and accessible yet isolated. The research and conservation projects are mostly “hands on” and require every member of the group to participate and contribute. The data collected is used to guide the management of the protected area and also spread environmental awareness within the surrounding Zulu communities.

Zingela has a strong research ethos headed up by the on-site owner/manager Dr. Peter Calverley who holds a PhD in Conservation Ecology, is an Honorary Researcher at the University of KwaZulu-Natal. Peter has partnered with several equally qualified and experienced scientists to put Zingela firmly on the map as a top research destination in South Africa.
